This is the fifth regional, juried exhibition presented by the Collective: An annual event to showcase the amazing diversity of work within this southern region.

Artists Collective | Spartanburg is the only studio art collective in Spartanburg County, and art is produced and displayed throughout the 20,000 square foot building. The exhibitions, workshops, performances, and educational opportunities, along with artists' studios, create a unique environment; a one-of-a-kind facility housing individuals who share a common creative consciousness.

The nonprofit organization has 32 studios and more than 50 member artists. Visitors from across the region and beyond visit the Collective during major exhibitions.

entry fee

All works will be allowed a single image per submission, plus one detail image. Entries will be accepted **Saturday July 1 - Monday July 31, 2023.**

submissions

Only original works of art produced within the past three years will be accepted in the following mediums:

- painting drawing sculpture ceramic glass
- photography printmaking jewelry textile
- basketry wood mixed media digital ai

No artwork from a kit or set will be accepted. Artists Collective | Spartanburg reserves the right to reject any work that differs dramatically from the image submitted.

Jewelry submissions must have their own secure vitrine.

All works to be hung must **be securely wired**, and if subject to damage, must be framed under plexiglas or glass. No sawtooth or clip mounting will be accepted.

Three-dimensional work must be able to sit solidly on a flat surface or be properly mounted for hanging, and must not exceed 36 inches in width or 72 inches in height, nor weigh more than 50 lbs. If works are not adequately prepared for display, they will be withdrawn from jurying.

Two-dimensional pieces should not exceed 36 inches by 48 inches including frame, regardless of orientation. Please keep in mind that entries must be transported or shipped by the artist and be prepared for hanging in a conventional gallery.

liability

Artists Collective | Spartanburg does not assume responsibility for insuring the works of art. All artwork will be handled with care while in our possession.

Upon physical delivery of work after acceptance by online jurying, Artists Collective | Spartanburg reserves the right to refuse any entry at its discretion if the image presented online misrepresented the work, or the work presents a danger or liability to the viewing public, and also reserves the right to photograph and reproduce for educational or marketing purposes any entry submitted.

The receipt of an entry in the juried exhibition will constitute agreement by the artist to all conditions set forth in the prospectus.

sale of work

All entries are available for sale unless otherwise noted. A 30% commission will be charged by Artists Collective | Spartanburg. If a work is Not For Sale, "NFS" must be noted on your entry card. No "POR"s (Price On Requests) will be accepted. Works for sale must have price listed and will be sold as exhibited.

the juror

Virginia DerryBerry Professor of Art, Drawing and Painting Emerita UNC Asheville

Her work is shown regularly in solo and group exhibitions throughout the United States and has been written about in an extensive list of publications including exhibition catalogs, the New American Paintings magazine and the Oxford American magazine. Solo exhibitions, such as Private Domain and Truth To Tell, have traveled during the past 5 years to venues in Nevada, North Carolina, South Carolina, Alabama, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Florida and Georgia.

Virginia DerryBerry's current artwork focuses on large scale figure narrative paintings which blend elements from mythology and alchemy, the forerunner of modern science. The intent is to suggest multiple interpretations rather than a straightforward illustration of a specific narrative, a fitting choice in that alchemy by its very nature is about the process of transformation. Passages of volumetric rendering set next to more abstract, painterly areas, result in the creation of a virtual, shifting world where nothing is quite what it seems.

Awards received during the past 10 years include: Outstanding Artistic Achievement from the Southeastern College Art Association; Visiting Artist at the American Academy in Rome (2010 and 2016); the Distinguished Teacher of the Year Award from UNC-Asheville and the Annual Artist Fellowship from the Southeastern College Art Association. In 2017, she was the recipient of the College Art Association's Distinguished Teaching of Art award and in 2020, was interviewed at the College Art Association's session on Amazing Women Artists.

In 2023, she was awarded an Artist Grant from the North Carolina Arts Council. Her drawings and paintings are in numerous private and public collections, including the Carnegie Museum in Pittsburgh, the Asheville Art Museum, the Tennessee State Museum, the State of West Virginia permanent collection, and the Morris Museum of Art. Two public art installations include 16 paintings at the Hartsfield-Atlanta International Airport and a 10 piece multipanel painting at the Knoxville Convention Center.
